IWUA Sets Water Law and Resource Issues Seminar For November 9-10 at The Riverside Hotel in Boise

The early registration deadline for the 34th Annual Water Law and Resource Issues Seminar, set for November 9-10 in Boise, is fast approaching. Presented by Idaho's largest and most influential water user organization, the Idaho Water Users Association, this seminar includes a broad scope of speakers and panels on issues affecting Idaho's water community.

The two-day seminar is being held at The Riverside Hotel.

“We are excited about the Seminar program. With presentations including the recently developed Idaho Position on the Columbia River Treaty, Tribal claims regarding fish passage through road culverts, the role of public relations in water delivery and a discussion of the new administration, there is something for everyone,” noted Paul Arrington, IWUA Executive Director and General Counsel.

Arrington said there has been a great deal of interest in the distinctive “SNOWMAGEDDON 2017!” program scheduled for Friday morning, November 10. The program features a variety of presentations looking at different aspects of the near-record snowfall last winter. Bureau of Reclamation officials have said 2016-17 was the second best all-time water year for the Treasure Valley, second only to 1943.
